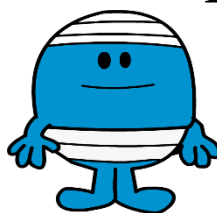

Bump Information



We are introducing a new text message service for parents/carers to inform them if their child has had a bump to their head during school hours. It is school policy that any child who receives a bump to the head must be seen immediately by a first aider and then given a bump note explaining what has happened. Miss Ryder will then send out a generic text message to let the parent know what has happened. This text service will only apply to children who have been treated by the first aider and are completely fine to stay in school. In any other situation where it is more serious Miss Ryder will telephone the parent/carer immediately.
