As from September 2018 our prices for school dinners will increase slightly from £2.30 a day to £2.40 a day (£12.00 a week).

As you are aware, over the years we have continued to keep the prices the same for dinners even though Manchester Fayre have increased theirs. Unfortunately now with the latest increase we have no option but to match the new costings which means we can no longer keep the same price.
